Introduction

At Himadri, we recognize that forests are critical to biodiversity, climate regulation, and community livelihoods. We are committed to eliminating deforestation from our operations, supply chains, and partnerships. This policy establishes our position on deforestation, ensuring that our business activities contribute to sustainable development and ecosystem resilience.

Scope

This policy applies to own operations, contractors, suppliers, partners and other stakeholders directly or indirectly involved in Himadri's operations and value chain activities.

Roles and Responsibilities

- **Executives and Line Managers:** Ensure that operations do not disrupt ecological balance, integrate biodiversity considerations into decision-making, and allocate necessary resources.
- **Employees:** Participate in conservation initiatives, adhere to relevant biodiversity laws and guidelines, and report any issues that may affect biodiversity.
- **Suppliers and Contractors:** Align practices with Himadri's biodiversity policy, actively contributing to conservation initiatives and adhering to biodiversity standards.

Our Commitments

- **No Gross Deforestation:** We commit to zero-gross deforestation across all commodities and supply chains by 2050.
- **No Net Deforestation:** Where unavoidable impacts occur, we will compensate through reforestation, restoration, or conservation programs to achieve zero-net deforestation by 2050.
- **Critical Commodities:** We will monitor and manage risks associated with commodities such as palm oil, soya, cotton, rubber, coffee, cocoa, and wood.
- **Priority Areas:** We will identify and disclose priority areas based on biodiversity risk assessments, including site proximity to sensitive ecosystems and high-risk biomes.
- **Sanction-Based Mechanisms:** Suppliers failing to meet our no-deforestation standards will face corrective actions, including potential exclusion from our supply chain.
- **Stakeholder Engagement:** We will collaborate with NGOs, certification bodies, local communities, and industry peers to strengthen monitoring and implementation.

- **Monitoring & Disclosure:** Compliance will be tracked through audits, satellite monitoring, and supplier reporting, with annual disclosure in our sustainability reports.

Governance and Policy Review

This policy is governed by Sustainability (ESG) Council of Himadri under the supervision of the Sustainability(ESG) committee at the Board level.

The policy will be reviewed every three years or as required by emerging biodiversity challenges or opportunities.
